Thank you for your interest in becoming a member of the National Junior Honor Society at Thomas Jefferson Middle School. Membership in NJHS is one of the highest honors that can be awarded to a student. Our chapter strives to give practical meaning and uphold the standards of: *scholarship, leadership, service, citizenship, and character*.

The five standards listed above will serve as the basis for the selection process. No student is inducted simply because of a high academic average. The National Junior Honor Society strives to recognize the total student; one who excels in all five chapter standards.

If you are chosen to be inducted into the Thomas Jefferson Chapter of the NJHS, you will be expected to:

- Maintain an average of at least 90% in all regular core subjects with nothing less than an 90% in electives, and at least an 85% in advanced/plus level core subjects.
- Participate in all NJHS meetings (scheduled via google classroom)
- Complete 10 hours of individual community service per school year is required for the NJHS. [New members are required to have 5 hours due before the induction ceremony in <u>March</u>. Previous members are required to have at least 5 by the end of January]. Service does not include that which is to immediate family members or a situation where you accepted payment.
- Participate in the NJHS Chapter community service project
- Demonstrate leadership, good citizenship and character at Thomas Jefferson Middle School and the community of Rockaway Borough
- Pay an annual due for the chapter of \$20 per member per year as per the NJHS organization
