- **Culminating event** - we will participate in a tournament against other schools with club volleyball teams on **March 5** at Valleyview MS in Denville. (Three divisions - boys, girls, co-ed.) \*Attending this event is a privilege and you will be chosen based on the expectations listed below. (Snow Date: March 8)
- **No conflicts** with other interscholastic sports! Limited conflicts with the school musical!
- **Participate in Fundraiser – All members MUST play/participate in our volleyball fundraising tournaments or help run the tournament in some way! The money raised buys the team UNIFORMS and BUSING to away events! (This is MANDATORY!)**
- Players must note the following expectations in order to be eligible to attend Club PRACTICES and the Club TOURNAMENT on March 5:
  - **Academics is key to participation!** Your grades will be monitored to ensure you are performing at an acceptable level. (More info to follow at organizational meeting. School Policy will be followed.)
  - **Behavior is also important!** Your behavior during the school day is important to your participation and will be monitored. (More info to follow at the organizational meeting.)
