REFERENDUM FACTS

The state has committed \$4.2 million in Debt Service (up to 40%) to Rockaway Borough for these projects.

WHY NOW?

Many items listed for replacement, repair and upgrade, have reached the end of their useful life and need more than routine maintenance.

TAXPAYER IMPACT

After state aid, the project will cost \$8.3 million (\$12.5 gross).

Yearly impact to an average \$301k household will be approximately \$250/year or \$21/month vs. \$331/year without Debt Service
