Dear Parents/Guardians:

Hope this letter finds you and your family well.

Even though we are currently 100% virtual, this letter is to inform you that an individual at Lincoln Elementary has tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). As in the past, the District is continuing to coordinate closely with public health officials and following CDC, state, and local health department guidance in order to assure the health and safety of our community. As a result, people or individuals who had contact with the diagnosed person, will or have been contacted by the local Board of Health or our school nurse with the necessary information.

Whether in school or at home, we understand the level of concern regarding COVID-19. We encourage parents and students to remain steadfast and continue following the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention promoted safeguards, such as:

- Staying home when you are sick;
- Washing hands often with soap for at least 20 seconds;
- Covering coughs and sneezes and properly disposing of tissues;
- Limiting close contact with people who are sick and not sharing food, drinks and utensils;
- Practicing social distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart);
- Wearing a face covering while in school; and
- Continuing to monitor your health for symptoms.
