The Teacher Cadet program is a one-year course open to qualifying junior and senior students who hope to pursue a career in education. The goal of the course is to encourage students who demonstrate strong interpersonal and leadership skills to consider a professional position in the educational system. The course allows students to examine all aspects of a possible teaching position through a rigorous, hands-on curriculum that incorporates three themes, that is experiencing the profession, the learning and the classroom. In addition, students are placed in a field experience in a local elementary school where they will be able to observe a cooperating teacher, and hopefully transfer their learning through the execution of an actual lesson/activity.
