

# When do tickets go on sale?

On March 10<sup>th</sup> at 5pm, the google form will be posted on our Facebook event and on our school website to pre-order a ticket package per attendee which includes admission. All attendees must purchase a package. <u>RBHSA Tricky Tray Admission & Ticket Form</u>
Please be advised that we expect to sell out rather quickly as only 250 attendees! The form and payment will all be online.

What's the whole process from ticket purchase, payment, confirmation, and pick up tickets?

1- Fill out the google form- RBHSA Tricky Tray Admission & Ticket Form (Link will be opened at 5pm on March 10th)

- 2- HSA will send an invoice via PayPal or Zelle as selected on the google form and payment must be made within 48 hours or your reservation will be canceled entirely.
- 3-Confirmation email will be sent once payment and form have been received (Double check this confirmation that you have the right number of people and tickets listed)
- 4-At the event, the table leader or individual will receive the entire packet of packages preordered. Keep your own records of who is at your table and what ticket packages they bought as we will not have that information.

## How do I reserve a table?

Tables can be reserved for 8 to 10 people. We have a limited number of tables that can have up to 11 people at a table.

#### What if I don't have 8 people in my party to reserve a private table?

You will be seated with other people to make up a total of 8 or 10 people. For example- if your party has 4 people, you will be seated together, along with others to fill the table.

## Can I buy more than one package? Can I split a ticket package with another person?

Yes, you can buy more than one package per person, but initial package cannot be split with another person as it serves as admission.

# What time do the doors open? Tickets pulled? Event end?

Doors open at 5:30pm. The first ticket will be pulled and called at 7 pm sharp. Plan for the event to go until 10 pm or later.

### How many baskets will there be?

# What is the difference between the different tiers?

- Low- Baskets are valued between \$45-\$99
- o Med-Baskets are valued between \$100-\$149
- o High-Baskets are valued between \$150-\$249
- o Grand-Baskets are valued at \$250+

## Can I purchase more tickets the night of?

Yes- extra tickets can be purchased with cash only the night of

- Low-\$10 per sheet (26 tickets)
- Med-\$15 per sheet (26 tickets)
- o High-6 tickets for \$10 or \$2 each
- o Grand- 6 tickets for \$20 or \$5 each

## Will there be a cash 50/50 Raffle?

Yes- be sure to bring extra cash! Last year, our 50/50 was over \$1000!

## Can I bring my own drinks?

White Meadow Lake will offer a full cash bar. All alcoholic beverages will need to be bought through the bar. You can purchase iced tea, soda and lemonade at the bar, too. Feel free to bring your own bottled water.

### Can I bring my own food?

Yes-and you should. There will not be any food sold at the event for purchase. Bring your own napkins, plates, cutlery, etc. Plan to bring your own appetizers, food, and dessert.

#### Will coffee be served?

Yes-complementary coffee will be provided.

#### Will there be a refund if I can't make the event for any reason?

No-you can give your tickets to a friend to enter your tickets

## Can children come to the event?

No-this is an 18 or older event to attend and 21 or older to consume alcohol and to put a ticket in a basket that contains alcohol.
