

What happens if the Referendum is NOT passed?

- State aid of \$4.2 Million dollars will NOT be given to district; it will go to other districts.
- We run the risk of boilers failing during the winter months and possibly closing school.
- Cost of All Projects will rise by 4.2 Million Dollars to local taxpayers.
- Timeline of 2 years to complete all projects will expand to 5 to 7 years.
- Net referendum cost to taxpayers of \$252 per year on average home assessment will rise to \$332 via yearly school budget increases.
- Daily instructional programs may be compromised, especially in case of an emergency.
