Interrupt, warn, and/or terminate a participant's statement, question, or inquiry when it is too lengthy; Interrupt and/or warn a participant when the statement, question, or inquiry is abusive, obscene, or may be defamatory;

Request any person to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum; Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person prevents or disrupts a meeting with an act that obstructs or interferes with a meeting;

Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting; and

Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or to maintain an orderly operation of the Board meeting.
